


Subject: How to use your LevelOne Bluetooth Dongle with WidComm software in Windows XP SP2??

Problem: I can not use Widcomm software as below picture after upgrade Windows XP to SP2.




1. Click **Start**, click **Run**




2. type **%windir%\inf** in the **Open** box, and then click **OK**.



3. Select **Tools**, then click **Folder Options...**




4. uncheck **“Hide extensions for known file types”** , then click **OK**.




5. Right-click **Bth.inf**, and then click **Rename**.


Rename Bth.inf to Bth.bak, and then press ENTER.



6. Check “**Hide extensions for known file types**” , then click **OK**.



7. Uninstall “**Generic Bluetooth Radio**” ,then unplug MDU-0001/5 from your computer.




8. Plug MDU-0001/5 into your computer again.

9. Select “No, not this time” ,then click next.
